



Outage Summary - June 11, 2026, Storm Event

If needed, customers can use the below power outage information in cases where employers are seeking proof or to satisfy requests for food/damage reimbursement provided by insurance carriers or other local resources. Due to the volume of individual requests from customers, NIPSCO is unable to provide an individual report for each customer.

Below is a list of communities that were affected by power outages caused by a severe weather event on Thursday, June 11, 2026. Outages affected an estimated 86,600 NIPSCO electric customers. NIPSCO restored 95% of customers by June 16, 2026, with some expected to extend into Wednesday, June 17, 2026.
